DOSBARTHADAU FFERMDY A CAWS ARBENNIG FARMHOUSE & SPECIALITY CLASSES

Exhibitors in farmhouse classes may not enter in creamery classes for the same variety. Farmhouse category applies to those exhibitors producing cheese from home produced milk or milk from their immediate locality. Traditional farmhouse cheesemaking techniques should have been used.

Please Note:

Cheeses may be whole or half blocks.

Please indicate on the entry form which you intend to exhibit

The Cheese Variety Should Be Stated On Each Exhibit.
Manufactured Date To Be Displayed On All Exhibits

- 1) Farmhouse Caerphilly.
- 2) Farmhouse hard pressed cheese (excluding any variety in class 1).
- 3) Farmhouse Smoked cheese, hard pressed.
- 4) Farmhouse cheese of any variety open to producer, producing not more than 5 tonnes / week.
- 5) Goat's milk cheese, any variety.
- 6) Ewe's milk cheese, any variety.
- 7) Cheese, any variety not to exceed 0.5kg any milk.
- 8) A cheese exhibited in retail packaging to be judged on taste and consumer appeal.
- 9) **NEW CHEESE** not previously exhibited at the Royal Welsh Show. Any variety, any milk.

CREAMERY CHEDDAR CHEESE CLASSES

- 10) Mild Cheddar, coloured, manufactured within the last 5 months.
- 11) Mild Cheddar, white, manufactured within the last 5 months.
- 12) Mature Cheddar, coloured, manufactured within 6 - 12 months.
- 13) Mature Cheddar, white, manufactured within 6 - 12 months.
- 14) Extra Mature Cheddar, **Wedge portion** not less than 2kg in weight of coloured or white, manufactured over 12 months.
- 15) Reduced fat cheese
- 16) Vegetarian cheese.

- 1 Any exhibit, should be sent to the Show, addressed to Miss Bethan Lewis, RWAS, Llanelwedd, Builth Wells, Powys, LD2 3SY and carriage paid. All exhibits must be collected between **5.30pm and 6.30pm** on Thursday 24 July 2008. Any exhibit left in the Hall after 6.30pm or will be disposed of as the Society sees fit.
- 2 No responsibility will be accepted by the Society for loss or damage to exhibits or any part thereof, during or after the exhibition nor will the Society be responsible for the loss of any item in transit to, or from, or in the Showground.
- 3 Exhibits must be staged after 4.00pm and before 7.00pm on Sunday 20 July or after 6.00am and before 8.30am on Monday 21 July 2008.
- 4 The Society make every effort to maintain exhibits at temperatures of 5°C (41°F) or lower during the complete period of the Show except for the Ice Cream classes which will be stored at a constant temperature of -18° or below. Products not held at the temperature required by law (Food Act 1990) must not be sold.
- 5 Exhibitors whose entry fees amount to a minimum of £10.00 will receive one day admission ticket to the show.
- 6 This section will be closed for judging between 9.00am and 12.30pm on the first day.
- 7 All exhibits must have been made by the exhibitor.
- 8 Badly deteriorated food will be discarded at the discretion of the stewards concerned.
- 9 Challenge Cups and trophies will be awarded to the winner of a class or section on Thursday 24th at 2.30 pm in the Produce and Handicraft Section (outside the Dairy Produce Pavilion). Under no circumstances will trophies be posted to winners. Trophies should be returned to the RWAS Headquarters by 1st May 2009. Special arrangements can be made for engraving but the winner is responsible for collection and deposit as above.
- 10 Protests. Any protest must be made in writing and handed in to the Chief Sectional Steward within two hours of judging, together with a deposit of £25.00 which will be returned if the protest is upheld.
- 11 Please mark the envelope enclosing your entry form 'Dairy Produce'.
