Rule 1.

Exhibits must be staged:
Between 11am and 6pm on Sunday 30th November.

Rule 2.

During staging times, exhibitors and officials only may remain in that part of the South Glamorgan Exhibition Hall.

Rule 3.

Exhibitors are entitled to enter one entry per class. Prizes will be awarded or withheld at the discretion of the judge whose decision is final.

Rule 4.

All exhibits must be collected between 5pm and 6pm on Tuesday 2nd December.
Any exhibit left in the South Glamorgan Exhibition Hall after 6pm will be the responsibility of the exhibitor.

Rule 5.

The section will be closed for judging between 8am and 10am Monday 1st December.

Rule 6.

A protest must be made in writing and handed to a Senior Steward within half an hour of judging, together with a deposit of £25.00 which will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

Rule 7.

No responsibility will be accepted by the Society for loss or damage to exhibits (or any portion thereof) or personal belongings before, during or after the exhibition, nor will the Society be responsible for the loss of any plant, flower or receptacle in transit to or from or on the Showground.

Rule 8.

A Rosette will be awarded to the first prize winners in each class. The Royal Welsh Agricultural Society Prize Cards will be also be presented to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed in each class. Prize money will be paid in cash by the Senior Stewards during the event.

Rule 9.

The Royal Welsh Agricultural Society will award Welsh Royal Crystal and a RWAS Rosette to the exhibitor gaining the Champion and Reserve Champion Best in Show Award, and Very Highly Commended, Highly Commended and Commended prize cards will be presented at the judge's discretion.

Rule 10.

Presentation of Awards will take place in the South Glamorgan Exhibition Hall on Tuesday 2nd
December at 3pm.
