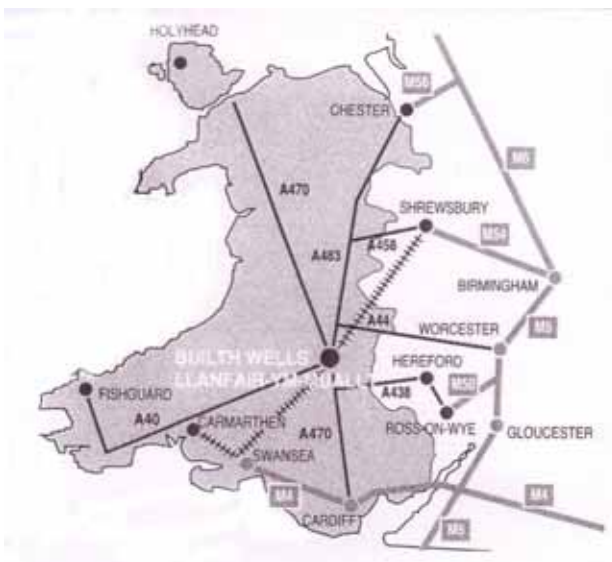

NODIADAU CYFFREDINOL / GENERAL NOTES

1. The Closing date for entries is Friday 4 April 2008.
2. **ENTRY FEE - £2.00 PER EXHIBIT**
3. Where 'handcrafted' work is specified, this is for work produced by means of knitting needles, a hand loom etc.
4. Where 'machinecrafted' work is specified, this is for work produced by means of a knitting machine or electrically/computer operated machine etc.
5. Where 'commercially produced' work is specified, this is for work produced jointly by the exhibitor and a commercial manufacturer.
6. PLEASE SPECIFY ON YOUR ENTRY FORM WHICH FIBRE YOU HAVE USED.
7. The display area will be lined with a medium green fine hessian backing material. Exhibitors may provide own backing material if desired.

HANDSPUN YARN & HANDCRAFTED SECTION (State on entry form if from own mohair)

Hank and square (approx 28gms(1oz) and 10cm.) in STOCKING STITCH and MOUNTED – Single Strand.

Dosbarth / Class 2

Dosbarth / Class 3

Hank and square (approx 28gms(1oz) and 10cm.) in STOCKING STITCH and MOUNTED – Fancy Yarn.

Knitted article.

Crocheted article.

Dosbarth / Class 6

Woven article.

GWOBRAU / AWARDS

1. Prize Cards & Rosettes will be awarded to 1st – 3rd placed exhibits in classes 1 – 15.
Classes 16 & 17 – Prize money will be awarded 1st - £2.50 2nd - £1.50 3rd - £1.00

Highly commended Rosettes will be presented at the judge's discretion.
2. The following trophies will be awarded:-
 - *The Angora International Stud Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the exhibitor gaining the highest number of points overall.
 - *The Angora International Stud Perpetual Trophy will be awarded for the best Angora Goat Skin.
 - *The Mary McCallun Bly Trophy, will be awarded to the Best in Show Exhibit together with a best in show BAGS rosette & prize money of £30 kindly sponsored by Caprafiba.
 - *Reserve Best in Show will be awarded a Reserve Best in Show BAGS rosette & prize money of £15 kindly sponsored by Preseli Mohair Centre.
 - *The Dewar Angora Mohair Craft Cup will be awarded for the best own grown mohair classes 1-9.
 - *The Moyann Shield for Crafts will be awarded for the best hand spun exhibit.

Non – Society Cups, Trophies and Awards

All cups, trophies and awards which are not the responsibility of the Society are marked*. Non Society cups, trophies and awards will not be engraved by the Society and will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to engrave and ensure its return to the registered office at BAGS or to a member of the Craft Committee before 1st May 2009.

RHEOLAU A RHEOLIADAU / RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Please complete entry form and return with the entry fee(s) no later than 4th April 2008 to:

2. Exhibits **must not** be sent with Entry Forms.
3. Any exhibit, if sent to the Festival, must be addressed and carriage paid to Miss Bethan Lewis,
Angora Goat Craft Section, RWAS Ltd, Llanelwedd, Builth Wells, Powys, LD2 3SY **by Friday 9th
May 2008**. Exhibits will only be returned if suitable packing and carriage is provided. Exhibits must
be staged between 6pm and 8pm on Friday 16th May or between 7am and 8am on Saturday 17th May
2008.
4. All exhibits must remain on display for the two days of the Festival and must be collected between
5.00pm and 6.00pm on Sunday 18 May 2008. Any exhibit left after 6.30pm on the Sunday will be
the responsibility of the exhibitor.
5. Wool or other fibre can be used in conjunction with the Mohair but a label showing the percentage
used must accompany the entry.
6. No responsibility will be accepted by the Society for loss of or damage done to exhibits or any part
thereof, during or after the exhibition nor will the Society be responsible for the loss of any item in
transit to, or from, or in the showground.
7. Any protest must be made in writing and handed to the Assistant Company Secretary within two
hours of judging, together with a deposit of £25.00 which will be returned if the protest is upheld.
8. The Society reserves the right to restrict or reject entries or to amalgamate, delete, curtail or expand
classes for any section of the Craft Competition without being called upon to give reasons for such
action.
9. The Section will be closed for judging on Saturday 17th May between 10.00am until 12.00 noon or
until judging is completed.
10. Prizes will be awarded or withheld at the discretion of the judges whose decision is final.
11. Entry fee per exhibit will be £2.00. All entry fees are inclusive of VAT. The following ticket
allocation will apply:-
1 – 2 Entries - 1 – Two day ticket
3 or more Entries - 2 – Two day tickets
Additional tickets available @ £7 each on request.
13. **After the completion of judging** exhibitors may display publicity material along side their exhibits.
14. Exhibitors must firmly attach their exhibitor number cards to all exhibits before bringing them to the
Festival.
15. Soiled, used or worn articles will not be accepted.
16. All work to be completely finished.
17. No exhibit will be returned to exhibitor without their “Brown Exhibitor Envelope”.
18. Exhibits that have previously won 1st prize in the Royal Welsh Smallholder and Garden Festival will
not be accepted.
